Must be pre-registered by April 24 to shoot. No late entries and no adding or Substitutes the day of the shoot. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!

Some minor changes are expected the day of the shoot, But the shooter has to be pre-registered.

8:00 a.m. Competition begins — 100 16 yard targets
All 100 targets will be shot from the same trap
Entry fee.....\$23.00
Practice round fee....\$6.00

DIVISIONS:

Missouri High School – 5 shooters from the same school, 9th through 12th grade. Missouri High School Open – 5 shooters from mixed high schools.

Missouri Junior High School – 5 shooters from the same school, 8th grade and below.

Missouri Junior High School Open – 5 shooters from mixed schools, 8th grade and below.

Missouri FFA – 5 shooters must be from the same school.

Missouri 4H – 5 shooters, must be from same club.

Missouri Lady Open – 5 lady shooters from same or mixed schools, but on same team.

Note: Open teams, FFA, 4H, and Lady's can use shooters of any age up to grade 12. State High School and Junior High Teams must stay in their age groups meaning High school 9-12 grade. Junior High age limit is 8th grade. Any team that must field a mix of Jr. High and Sr. High students will compete in High School Open category.

ALL TEAMS MUST HAVE A CERTIFIED COACH ATTENDING.

All shooters must be on their team roster and have a MTA consent release and waiver form on file. These forms must be filed with MTA prior to competition.

INDIVIDUAL AWARDS

High Over-All
Senior Class
Champion, Runner-Up, Third

Note: A lady Shooter must declare which category before they shoot. They

can only win one trophy.

Shoot Offs: Any Team Ties will be shot off with 25 additional targets.

Individual High Over-All only will be shot off 10 additional 16yd

targets and move back if ties still exists, 22yd, 25yd and 27yd till tie is broke.

If time permits other ties will be miss and out. If time is a factor reverse score by sub event will be used.

RULES OF THIS SHOOT Safety-Safety-Safety!!!

No toe pads!!!!

- Pads on the ground where shooters can rest their muzzle between shots will be allowed.
- Your muzzle must be held in a safe downrange position. If you have a shooter who cannot comply with this rule the solution is simple. Don't enter the shoot...NO EXCEPTIONS!
- All shooters must wear eye and hearing protection. (NO EXCEPTIONS)
- All guns must be carried OPEN and unloaded at all times
- No moving from post to post with a loaded gun.
- Shooters must be courteous at all times.
- No horseplay, running, or yelling on or off the firing line.
- Management has the right to disqualify anyone not complying with all ATA safety rules.
